



ISCPP ANNUAL AWARDS PROGRAM AWARDS CRITERIA

THE CRIME PREVENTION PEOPLE™

Criteria and Nominating Procedures

1. An ISCPP member in good standing must make all nominations and no member may nominate himself or herself for the George B. Sunderland Award.
2. The nominee for the George B. Sunderland Award must contain information about the nominee's contributions to crime prevention during his-her career(s). All other awards shall reflect activities conducted one year prior to the award application submission date.
3. The nominee must not have been a previous recipient of an award for the same category within the past three years. **The George B. Sunderland award will be for an entire career. This is a one-time only award.**
4. A nominee may be nominated in more than one category, but separate supporting documentation, letters of endorsement and separate application is necessary. Do not make reference to information from another application.
5. Documentation should be concise and specific. Documentation must include and is limited to:
 - a) A one-page cover letter from the nominator.
 - b) Nomination form included in this packet.
 - c) A 5 x 7 photograph of person, program or project (if available).
 - d) No more than five double spaced pages of the award nomination criteria. **Please provide the following information in your narrative:**
 - i. Describe the crime prevention programs that this individual or organization is involved in (include the year the activities began).
 - ii. How was the individual or organization involved?
 - iii. Describe the uniqueness of the activities, services, or material developed by the person or organization. What makes this program, person, or unit outstanding?
 - iv. How many people, particularly volunteers are actively involved in the program.
 - v. Identify support within the community and involvement with other organizations (including size of population affected and funding resources).
 - vi. List other recognition received for this individual, unit or activity.
 - vii. Include any additional information that supports this nomination.
 - e) One letter of endorsement from a local, state or province official who can verify the information contained in the information packet. This letter must reference the nominee and be included in the submitted nomination packet. **This letter cannot be from the nominator.**

- f) No more than three letter-size pages of material to support the program or person. This may be newspaper articles, handouts, thank-you letters etc.
6. We prefer if the nominations are emailed (please request confirmation of receipt) to the ISCPP Awards Committee Chair Cheryl Elliott, ICPS at celllott@iscpp.org by February 15, 2010.
 7. If email is not available, please send four (4) copies of the nomination packet including all information and attachments post marked by February 15, 2010 to Lt. Cheryl Elliott, Emory University Police, 1784 N. Decatur Rd, G01, Atlanta, GA 30322. **Late entries will not be judged.** Packets must be sent in their entirety. **No faxed copies will be accepted. All nominations must be in the English language.**
 8. All nomination materials will become the property of the ISCPP and will not be returned. Do not send original booklets, pins or videos.
 9. Nominations will be screened for completeness and compliance with the established criteria. Nominations not following these guidelines will not be considered. Information included in the nominee's packet must be verifiable upon request.
 10. The cost of travel to the Awards Banquet, hotel, meals and extra expenses are the responsibility of the award winner, their agency or sponsoring organizations. The ISCPP will provide two complimentary tickets to the award winners to attend the Award Banquet.
 11. Any additional attendees may attend the Awards Banquet for a cost of \$35 per person US.

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ISCPP ANNUAL AWARDS NOMINATION CATEGORIES

1. **George B. Sunderland Practitioner of the Year – Lifetime Achievement Award**

To annually recognize the significant contributions made by the outstanding crime prevention practitioners whose exceptional dedication and enthusiasm for crime prevention has provided a positive impact on the quality of life for others. [Note: This is a one-time only award – based on an entire career]

Category I: Over 100,000 Population Category II: Under 100,000 Population
Category III: Military (any size)

2. **Unit of the Year**

To annually recognize the outstanding crime prevention units which have made the most significant contributions to the crime prevention profession. This category includes all police initiated programs-projects.

Category I: Over 100,000 Population Category II: Under 100,000 Population
Category III: Military (any size)

3. **Volunteer of the Year**

To annually recognize the outstanding contributions made by crime prevention volunteers whose exceptional dedication and commitment to crime prevention has enhanced crime prevention initiatives at local, state-province, and national levels.

Category I: Over 100,000 Population Category II: Under 100,000 Population

4. **Business of the Year**

To annually recognize the outstanding crime prevention programs of a profit-making business that have made the most significant contribution to the prevention of crime for their organizations or for their community.

Category I: Local – City Category II: State – Province
Category III: National – International

5. Media of the Year

To annually recognize the significant contribution to crime prevention made by a specific media organization.

Category I: Electronic

Category II: Print

6. Community Crime Prevention Program-Project

To annually recognize the outstanding NON-POLICE community based crime prevention program-project (service clubs, PTA, schools, non-profits, etc.) which enhanced crime prevention initiatives at the local, state-province, or national level.

Category I: Over 100,000 Population

Category II: Under 100,000 Population

7. State – Province Programs & Associations

To annually recognize the outstanding State – Province Programs and Associations which enhance crime prevention initiatives.

Category I: Over 200,000 Population

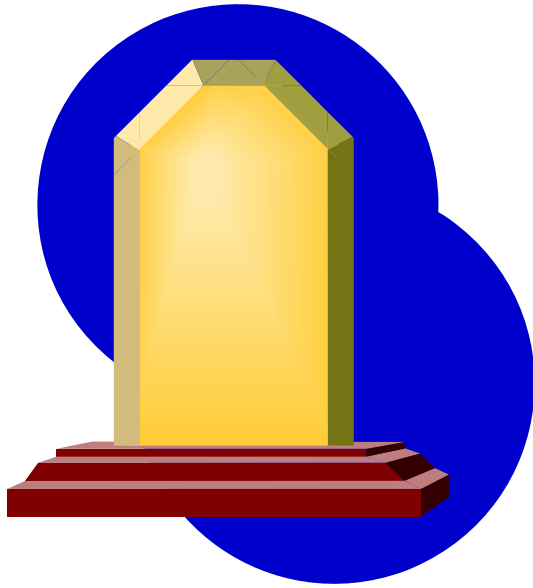
Category II: Under 200,000 Population

8. Ann Howell Youth Award

To annually recognize the outstanding youth based program, individual or project in the field of crime prevention. The youth group or individual's exceptional dedication and enthusiasm for crime prevention have provided a positive impact on the quality of life for others. [Note: This award is for individuals between the ages of 13 – 21 years.]

Category I: Over 100,000 Population

Category II: Under 100,000 Population
